

Town Centre Changes for Social Distancing in Stratford upon Avon

The initial changes made to the town centre by Warwickshire County Council [WCC] didn't work very well so after listening to the local Councils, businesses, taxi owners and myself representing blue badge users a compromise was reached to open up the town but retain some social distancing.

However, this is directed by Government to WCC due to Covid-19 so could change at any time and would be beyond our control.

High Street is closed every day from 11:00am - 6:00pm which allows the road to become a pedestrian area [similar to Upper Henley Street], with the opportunity to sit and have refreshments outside local coffee shops too.

Pavement licences can be purchased by Stratford District Council [SDC] for businesses to make use of their tables and chairs.

Bridge Street [Boots side] still has a wider pavement with barriers from High Street to Waterside to allow social distancing.

Bridge Street [M&S side] has 9 car parking spaces followed immediately by the re-instated bus stop. There is also some fixed wooden table and seating, which isn't inclusive, protected by barriers.

Blue badge parking is mainly in Union Street but also look at my guide for other town locations.

Taxi bays are available in Union Street and around town.

Bus stops are in Guild Street, Bridge Street, Wood Street and Windsor Street.

Park & ride has re-started but drops off by the Fountain in Wood Street which is a long way from the shops.

Town station is accessible with full toilet facilities.
